Organization Tips for Success in the Classroom

- When purchasing your school supplies for the upcoming school year, try **color-coding** your subject materials. For example, Science materials could be all colored green (think science, leaves, chlorophyll, etc), and Language Arts items could be colored blue, (ie. blue=ink). Associating a certain color with subject materials (folders, spirals, binders...) make it easier to remember which subject color you are looking for when grabbing items from lockers in a hurry!
- Be sure to clearly **label all of your school items**. Jackets, notebooks, pencil pouches get lost easily, and if found cannot be returned to an unknowing student unless clearly labeled.
- Please **avoid bringing items of value** that are not school related-these are definitely a distraction during the school day and not permitted to be used. Examples of some of these items are cell phones, electronic game systems, and head phones, as use of these items during the school day can result in disciplinary action, and possibly even loss or theft!
